



Cloverdale Paint WEATHERONE[®] MC

15 and 25 YEAR LIMITED TRANSFERRABLE WARRANTY FOR 709-SERIES WEATHERONE MC COATING

Cloverdale Paint Inc. ("Cloverdale") warrants its 709-series WeatherOne MC Coating, subject to the conditions contained in this limited Warranty for **twenty-five (25)** years where two full coats¹ have been applied and **fifteen (15)** years where one coat has been applied to properly primed² and prepared³ fibre-cement siding by **Fisher Coatings** ("Applicator"). This Warranty shall be transferrable to subsequent owners of the building to which the fibre cement siding has been installed provided that proof of purchase can be provided by the subsequent owner(s). This warranty will be effective from the date of application and is subject to certain conditions as outlined in this warranty.

When applied following full label and technical data sheet instructions, this product will:

- **NOT** chalk to discolor the surrounding surfaces.
- **NOT** erode to expose the substrate.
- **NOT** peel or blister from properly prepared surfaces.
- **NOT** become damaged by normal maintenance and cleansing of dirt.

Conditions:

• This warranty applies where one or two coats of 709 Series WeatherOne MC has been applied by the Applicator to properly primed and prepared exterior fibre cement board. If failure has occurred within the Warranty period as measured from the date of application, and all other Conditions and Limitations of this Warranty have been met; as its sole liability and in lieu of any direct, indirect or consequential damages, Cloverdale will reimburse the owner according to the following schedule:

- Years 0 – 5 Reimburse the owner for paint costs and labour up to \$1.00 per square foot of defective surface area
- Years 6 – 15 Reimburse the owner for paint costs and labour cost diminishing by 10% per year through year 15.
- Years 16 – 25 Reimburse the owner for paint costs only.

Any product found to be defective for any reason prior to application must not be installed and must be returned to the dealer from where the product was purchased. Cloverdale will not be responsible in any way for materials or labour if defective product has been installed, nor be responsible for consequential or special damages or the cost of accessories (building paper, fasteners, caulking, sheathing etc.) that may arise in connection to this Warranty.

Limitations:

- This Warranty does not cover Chaulking, Peeling, Erosion, Blistering, Efflorescence and normal Cleansing Damage where the cause of this damage is from a defective or inadequate primer as supplied /applied by the fibre-cement siding manufacturer.
- This Warranty does not cover damage to the Coating as a result of failure of the substrate including, but not limited to: cupping, warping, cracking, excessive dimensional changes or breakdown. This Warranty furthermore does not cover damage as a result of installation, falling objects, improper storage, accidental damage or structural defects.
- This Warranty does not cover damage as a result of fire, flood, lightning, hurricane, earthquake or other extreme weather conditions or acts of God.
- This limited warranty does not apply to damage caused by alteration of this product, misuse, improper storage, pressure washing, neglect or the effects of harmful cleaning chemicals.
- This warranty does not apply to other applications of this product on surfaces or materials not listed above. This would include, but not be limited to: wood siding, shakes or shingles, vinyl siding, aluminum siding, concrete, cement block (MCUs), plastic or composite plastic materials.
- Mildew, algae and colour permanence are beyond the control of Cloverdale and are explicitly not covered by this Warranty. Depending on colour, additional coat(s) may be required to provide aesthetically desirable results.
- This limited warranty will only apply if Cloverdale is notified of such failure in writing within thirty (30) days of such failure occurring and Cloverdale is afforded an opportunity to inspect and conduct tests of such areas as deemed expedient and necessary.

Except for the limited Warranty expressly provided above, to the maximum extent permitted by applicable law, Cloverdale disclaims all other warranties.

All claims must be submitted in writing and accompanied by proof of purchase. Claims may be made at the Cloverdale location where the product was purchased or mailed to the address below.

1. Full coats are defined as the specified spread rate per application and dry times observed between applications as per manufacturer instructions.
2. Fibre cement siding must be primed with a factory primer or Cloverdale 05133 Alkali Resistant Primer
3. Prepared as per Cloverdale published literature and as per standard industry practices.
